- 5. The professional instrument players (even other than UTU students) are allowed in a team but will not be sponsored by college or university.
- 6. Judging of this event will be on the basis of quality of singing, tune, rhythm and coordination.
- 7. The decision of judges will be the Final.
- 8. The entries will only be finalized after screening (Date of screening will be announced shortly).
